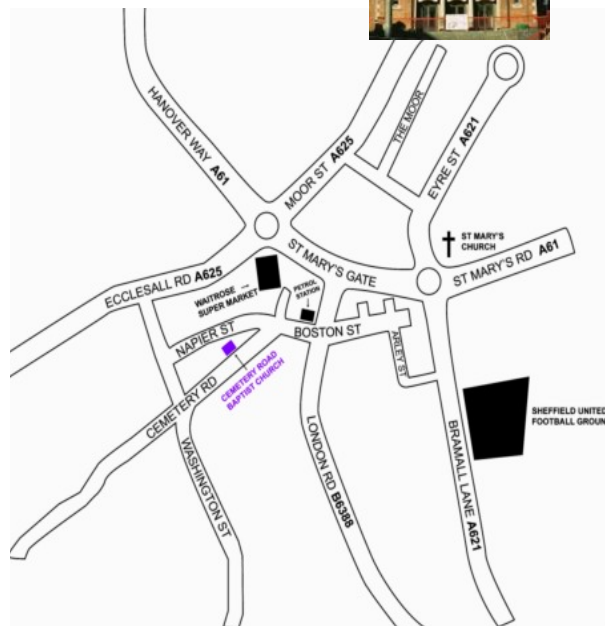

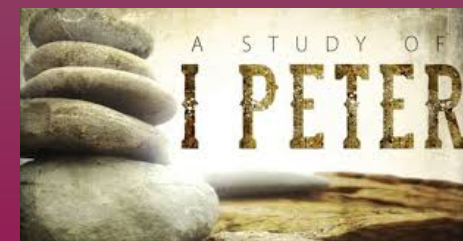

SERMON SERIES SUMMER 2016

In our services over the next few weeks we have a variety of speakers. Claire and John are coming to the end of their time with us as ministers in training, and we wish them well in their next stages of ministry. We welcome back Nigel Manges, our former minister, who will be preaching at our anniversary celebration.

In our morning services from June we shall be exploring the book of I Peter and asking what it means to be living stones in our context today.



Sunday **morning services** have a mix of the traditional and contemporary incorporating a singing group, organ, music group, and drama. The services last about an hour and a quarter and include a children's talk and sermon. Young people go out to one of four Junior Church classes midway through the service. There is a crèche facility.

There are also refreshments served after both services at the back of Church.

The **evening services** tend to be more reflective in nature and alternate between meeting in the main sanctuary of the Church, and the upstairs Conference room (2nd and 4th Sundays of a month), when often one of the Home Fellowship Groups will lead.

Throughout the week there are services, study groups, events and activities in which to be involved.





Currently, we have extra services and Fellowship Groups for Iranian (Thursdays 7pm) and Congolese (Sundays 2pm) members.

We usually celebrate Holy Communion on the third Sunday morning and first Sunday evening of the month.
